Clothing for all ages in almost new condition, clean and in good repair

Footwear for all ages in like new condition.

Furniture and Lamps (but not hard-wired lighting fixtures)\*\*

**We Cannot accept the following items due to space limitations, and safety and liability issues:**

Infant Car seats, strollers, high chairs, cribs
